PowerPoint – Highlights the career survey, uncommon job, & summarizes the career shadow experience and how it benefited your career goals. Organized, neat & includes photos and other related graphics	15	
Career Test Results – Top 4 interest groups identified and discussed.	5	
Background Research – Includes some background on the job you shadowed (see page 8) in the packet	5	
Career Interest Groups - Describe your career interest groups. Explain why you picked the career your project focuses on, and how it relates to your career interest groups results.	10	
Focusing Career Choices - Evidence of skills and education needed for the job shadow career. How does your future plan for education help prepare you to reach this goal.	10	
Interview/Job Shadowing - Provide a summary of your interview/job shadow experience. Include a reflection about your thoughts about your interview experience/job shadowing. Provide evidence	10	
Packet - Packet is complete and filled out in detail.	15	
Conclusion/Reflection - Discusses what was learned about oneself and career planning, if the career interviewed is a good match (why or why not); would you interview/job shadow the same career if you were to do this project over (why or why not); what are the next steps for your career planning.	10	
Acknowledgements – Acknowledgement of person(s) that you job shadowed/interviewed, including thank you notes:	5
